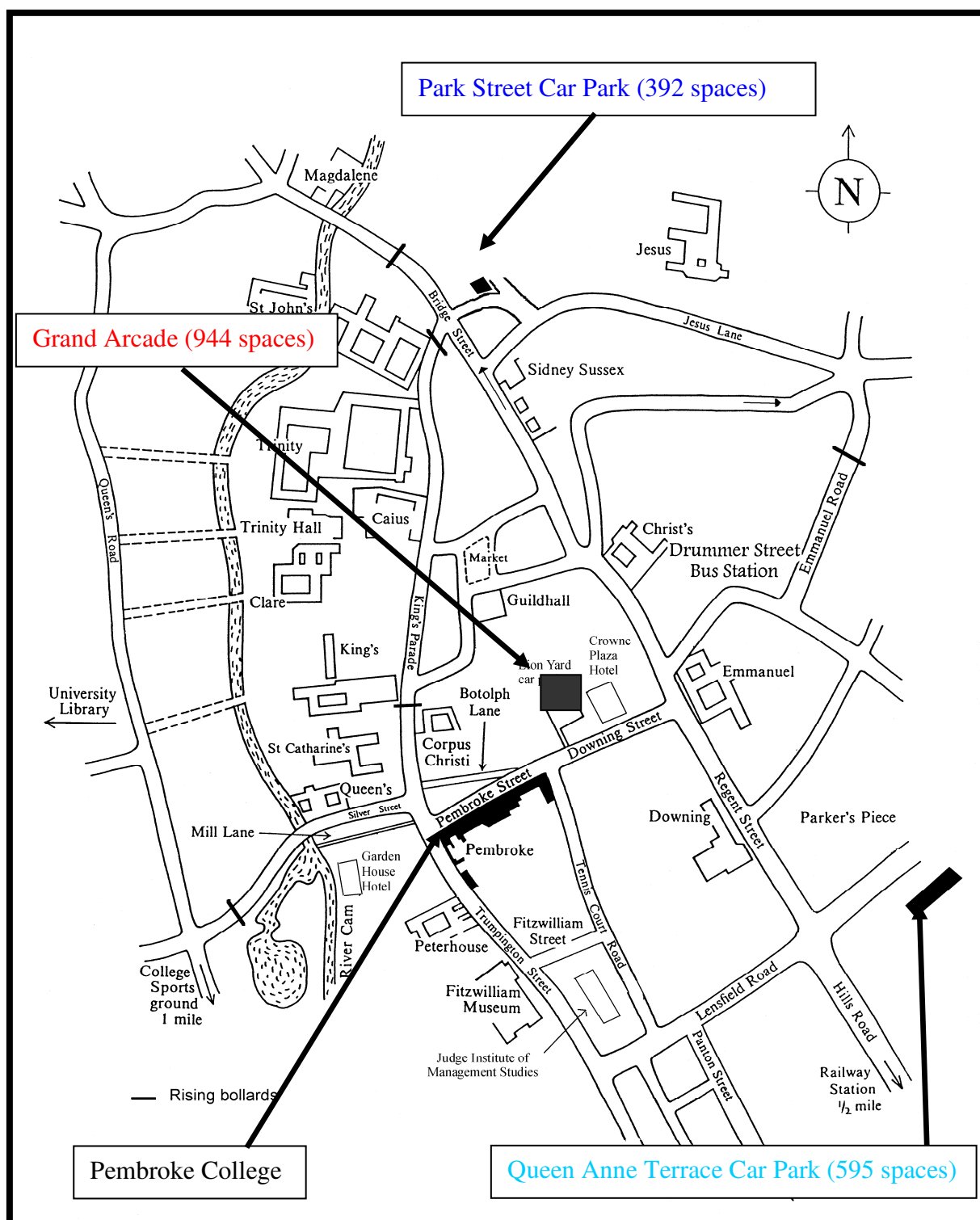

PARKING IN CENTRAL CAMBRIDGE

The nearest car park to the College is the Grand Arcade Car Park, formerly known as Lion Yard, with 944 places. Access to the Grand Arcade Car park is via [Tennis Court Road](#) (a one-way street) with traffic flowing from Lensfield Road to Pembroke Street. For your visit to Pembroke you should be prepared to consider alternatives, such as the Queen Anne Car Park on Gonville Place, next to Parkside swimming pool, which has a capacity of 595 spaces and is only a short walk across Parker's Piece from the College, or Park and Ride

There are signs on the approach roads to the city centre giving details of the number of free spaces in all of the city's car parks.

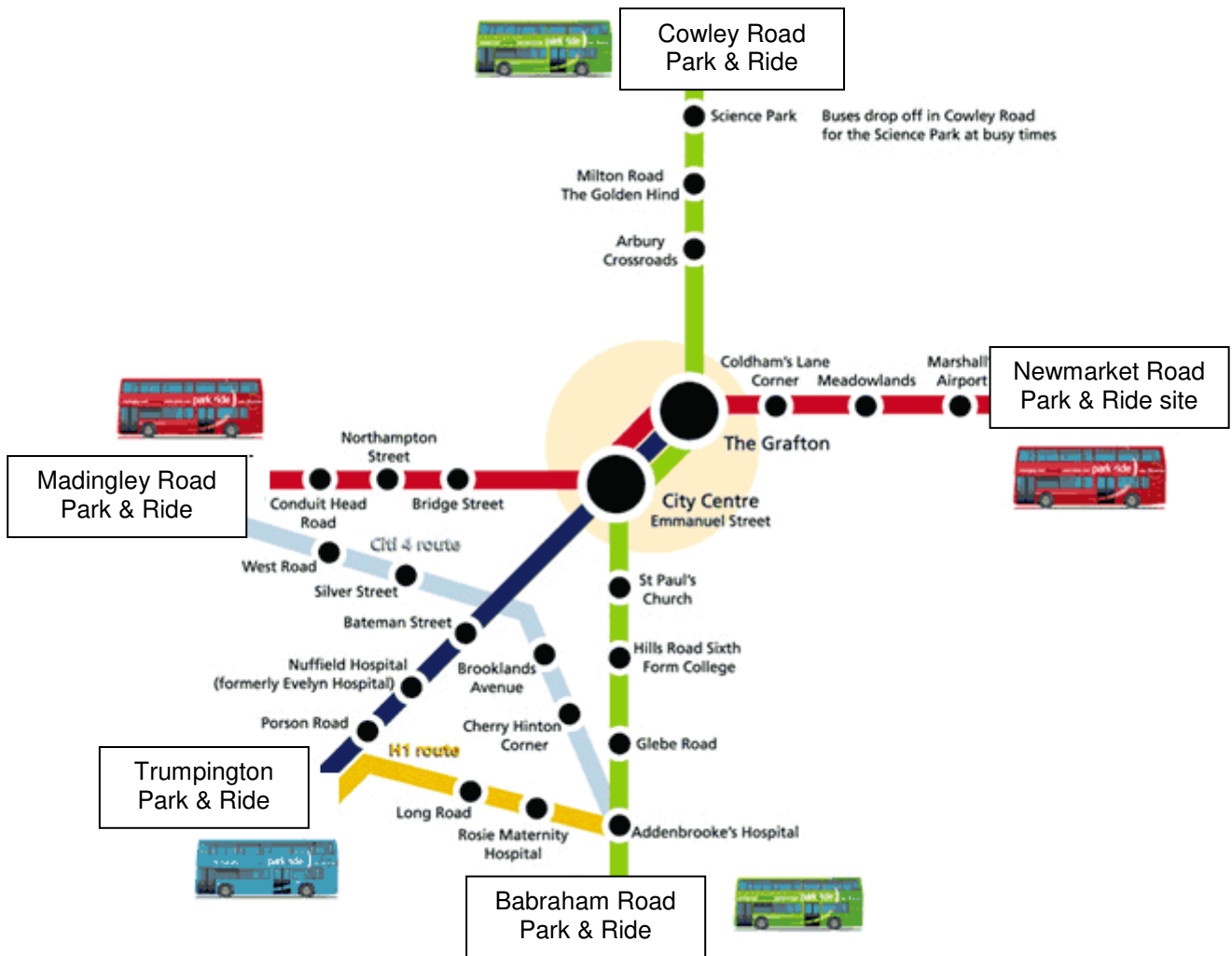

PARK AND RIDE

Alternatively, there are five Park and Ride sites around the outskirts of the city, with frequent buses into the centre. Overnight car parking is **NOW** permitted at Park and Ride. Daily tickets are purchased from ticket machines outside the main building on each site. There are no barriers and the ticket does not need to be displayed in the vehicle. The system uses cameras that have automatic number plate recognition on entrances and exits. **Failure to purchase a ticket after 1 hour will be treated as a parking violation** and enforcement action taken by the issuing of a Penalty Charge Notice. The £1 ticket allows a stay of up to 18 hours, even into the next day. Parking for longer than 18 hours is allowed with the additional charges – up to 24 hours: £10, up to 48 hours: £20, up to 72 hours: £30. Tickets are available from the ticket machines or can be purchased in advance using the online form on the Park and Ride website (next page). Bus tickets (£3 return) may be purchased from the machines or from the driver. All Park and Ride SITES run a Sunday service. Buses run every 15 minutes between 9am and 6pm). The Park and Ride sites are:

South:	Trumpington Babraham Road	take Junction 11, M11 towards Cambridge off A 1307 from the Gog Magog roundabout
East:	Newmarket Road	A1303 from A14/A1303 Stow Cum Quy interchange
North:	Cowley Road	off A 1309 Milton Road from A14/A10 junction
West:	Madingley Road	A1303 off Junction 13, M11
